Notifications

- Email notifications come from notifications@shelterlock.com
- Text Notifications come from: 855-999-7021

FOB Notifications Available

- **Critical Battery** (Lock button on the FOB will flash red every 30 seconds)
- Lockdown Button Pressed
- Self-Test Button Pressed

Lock Notifications Available

- Critical Battery (Also, to be noted, the LED on the lock will long flash red and the lock will beep when the 9KX has reached critical battery)
- Lockdown event
- **Lockdown hardware failure** (The notification should also note which lock failed)
- Self-Test Failure (Lock Failed Self-test No notifications for self-test = good news)
- Tamper Activated (Electronics removed from lock)
- Tamper Deactivated (Electronics returned to door)
- **Communication Offline** (Offline for more than 40 hours per the manual page 15)

Gateway Notifications Available

 Communication Offline (Offline more than 25 minutes, per manual page 15.)

Repeater Notifications Available

- Lockdown Event (Locked down through FOB lock button being depressed or via repeater switch)
- Lockdown Switch Activated (Locked down by switch wired to repeater)
- Lockdown Restored Switch Activated (Locked down restore via switch at repeater.)
- **Communication Offline** (offline more than I hour per manual page 15.)

- Notification Example: Tamper Inactive
 - Company = Clevz
 - Tamper Inactive: Type of Notification (tamper alarm has cleared)
 - Device: B10 19ee = Name of the lock

SHELTER system alert at Clevs: Lockdown Button Pressed: Device: 00:00:6F:FF:FF:32: Gateway: Damon's APU2 Time: 7/28/2017 4:44 PM

- Notification Example: Lockdown Button Pressed
 - Company = Clevz
 - Device = 00:00:6F:FF:FF:32 (FOB name, this FOB was not assigned a friendly name (Jane Doe or Bob Smith) so the default MAC address is used.) This notification tells you who signaled the lockdown
 - Gateway: Device: Damon's APU2 (Portal Gateway name)

SHELTER system alert at Clevs: Lockdown! Check device status: Gateway: Damon's APU2: Time: 8/2/2017 3:42 PM

- Notification Example: Lockdown!
 - Company = Clevz
 - Check Device Status: Doors (Either 9KX or Repeaters or both) were locked down through a
 gateway
 - Gateway: Damon's APU2 The portal Gateway that received the lockdown, helpful if you
 have multiple portals or facilities with portals under the same company

SHELTER system alert at Clevs: Self-Test Failure: Device: B1 19B0: Time: 8/28/2017 12:57 PM

- Notification Example: Self-Test Failure
 - Company = Clevz
 - Self-Test Failure: Lock failed self-test.
 - B1 19B0: Device that failed the self-test.
