
FAIL SAFE/FAIL SECURE CONVERSION

MORTISE LOCK SERIES: EM303, EM303F, LSEM303, LSEM303F




MORTISE LOCK SHOWN WITH LOCK COVER REMOVED

- Remove the SOLENOID MOUNTING SCREW from the bottom of the LOCK CASE.
- Remove the three screws from the lock cover and then remove the lock cover. (NOT SHOWN)
- 3 Disconnect the ELECTRIC LOCK SPRING, then remove the SOLENOID and ELECTRIC LOCK SLIDE.
- A Rotate the ELECTRIC LOCK SLIDE to obtain the desired function. See Diagrams.

 Fail Secure: (see diagram #1) the function slots will be away from the SOLENOID.

 Fail Safe: (see diagram #2) the function slots will be toward the SOLENOID.








DIAGRAM #1 FAIL SECURE

5. Reinstall the SOLENOID with its pin in the ELECTRIC LOCK SLIDE, while positioning the ACTUATOR into its notch. (See diagram #3)



- 6. Reinstall the SOLENOID mounting screw.
- 7. Attach the ELECTRIC LOCK SPRING.
- 8. Reinstall the lock cover and secure with the three screws.
